## **Dual Credit Transcripts**

High school counselors/advisors asked the following questions about transcripts. This document will be updated as details change, additional questions are added, and as more Idaho colleges respond to the request for information.

	How does a student request a dual credit transcript?	What is the cost of a dual credit transcript?
University of Idaho	Transcripts can be ordered online through the National Student Clearinghouse.	Official transcripts cost \$12.50. For more details, view the U of I Transcripts page.
College of Western Idaho	Dual Credit students can order an official CWI transcript through the National Student Clearinghouse. If they visit https://cwi.edu/current-students/transcripts, the link to order a transcript is on the top right. This process is the same for all students (Dual, Matriculated, etc.) who took courses with CWI, and are now seeking to send their official transcript elsewhere.	The cost is determined by the method of delivery.  Electronic: \$5 Hold for Pickup: \$5 Mail: \$5 FedEx/United States: \$25 FedEx/International: \$50 Overnight Mail: \$35
College of Eastern Idaho	Students can request a transcript <u>online</u> , through the CEI website, or by submitting a <u>paper form</u> .	The cost is \$10.
Boise State University	Students can do this online through the BSU <u>registrar's webpage</u> .	Price varies for express delivery, however for standard it is usually \$10-11.
Brigham Young University - Idaho	Students request their transcripts from the Student Records and Registration office online at <a href="https://www.byui.edu/transcripts">https://www.byui.edu/transcripts</a> .	BYU-Idaho has two options, a paper transcript or an electronic transcript. The prices vary according to the method of mailing a paper transcript. An electronic transcript is \$1.50.
