The Process:

2. You may do your own research outside of the sources provided. It may be especially helpful to look at YOUR high school's website to see what offerings exist that are specific to YOU. ***Make sure to include a link/citation for any additional sources that you use.*
3. Log your evidence on the document provided. You will need at least three pieces of evidence for each category. ***Don't forget to cite where each piece of evidence came from.*
4. When you have collected all your evidence, complete the reflection activity.
