Early Graduation Scholarship



The Early Graduation Scholarship is a scholarship available to Idaho public school students, who graduate at least one full year early. The scholarship is equal to 35% of the Average Daily Attendance (ADA) for a given school year. This equates to an estimated \$1,800. The award amount will double for students who graduate two years early and will triple for students who graduate three years early.

Idaho GEAR UP Scholarship

Idaho Governor's Cup Scholarship

(Academic)

AMOUNT: \$5,000 per year

ELIGIBILITY / REQUIREMENTS: Cumulative 2.8 GPA • No FAFSA • ACT/SAT recommended • Requires an essay and two letters of recommendation

DEADLINE: March 1

Idaho Governor's Cup Scholarship (CTE)

AMOUNT: \$3,000 per year

ELIGIBILITY / REQUIREMENTS: Cumulative 2.8 GPA • No FAFSA • ACT/SAT recommended • Requires an essay and two letters of recommendation

DEADLINE: April 15

MANAGED BY IDAHO GOVERNOR'S CUP.

Armed Forces or PSO Dependant Scholarship

AMOUNT: Tuition/fees, housing (on campus full-time), books/supplies

REQUIREMENTS: No minimum GPA • No FAFSA

ELIGIBILITY: Dependents of fallen or permanently disabled (to the point that they are unemployable) Idaho members of the armed forces or Idaho public safety officers.

Reach out to the State Board for an eligibility prescreening interview.

DEADLINE: Open

MANAGED BY IDAHO STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

Idaho LAUNCH Grant Program

AMOUNT: Up to \$8,000 or 80% of the cost of the program (whichever is less)

ELIGIBILITY / REQUIREMENTS: No minimum GPA • No FAFSA

• Pathway Activity Completion • Qualifying programs determined by the Workforce Development Council
