\*If you are a private school student, homeschool or GED student who does not have an EDUID you may leave the EDUID field blank. If you attend a public school and do not have access to your EDUID you may also leave it blank but please note doing so you will require you to manually link your Next Steps Idaho account to your Scholarship Idaho account later in the Idaho LAUNCH grant application process.

# Complete your Idaho LAUNCH grant application in Scholarship Idaho

Visit scholarships.idaho.gov

What you will need:

☐ Your Idaho Drivers's License Number or Idaho State Identification Card.

If you do not have a drivers license or state identification card, the Idaho DMV will issue a state identification card for FREE. You can come back to add this information once you have it.
