

# Request Transcripts

*Suggested timeframe of completion: February 1- May 15*

Colleges are not the only organizations that might request a copy of your high school transcript to accept your application for education, training, or a job. Employers may also ask for this document when they are reviewing your resume for a job or apprenticeship.

A high school transcript is the official record of your academic accomplishments starting in 9<sup>th</sup> grade and ending 12<sup>th</sup> grade. It lists all the classes you took, when you took them, and the grades you received. Colleges carefully review your transcript during the application process. Employers might ask for a transcript to check out your grades but also see if you've taken any classes that might be directly applicable to the job you're applying for.
