

Keeping Admissions Assessments Up to Date

Suggested timeframe of completion: Beginning of School Year- October 1

As a junior you were required to take the SAT. Depending on your score and the requirements at the colleges where you plan to apply, you might be considering retaking the SAT or taking the ACT for the first time. You still have time to retake or take an additional college entrance exam to improve your scores or provide an alternative to present to colleges and universities where you're applying.

Depending on what major or program of study you are pursuing after high school, some colleges may require an additional SAT subject test as a prerequisite before you can declare certain majors. If you believe that may be the case, check the SAT and ACT websites for subject test dates to ensure you don't miss out on the opportunity to apply to the college of your choice.
