Idaho College Acceptance Letter – What do I do next?

Sometime between November 1 and November 13, you and your parents will be receiving nearly identical letters from the State Board of Education and Governor Otter. These letters will tell you (and your parents) which Idaho colleges and/or universities have accepted you based on your grades and SAT/ACT scores.

Congratulations!

But you're not done yet. Next, you will need to do some research on which of your options is the best fit for what you want to study and what kind of college community fits you best. We've put together an [Idaho Schools Directory](#) to help you learn more about our public institutions.

Once you've decided which school you want to attend, you need to follow their normal application procedures, even though you've been accepted. Your letter will hold your seat for the fall of 2016 but you still need to submit the required forms and, of course, graduate from high school! **To take advantage of your pre-acceptance offer, you must submit your application materials by February 15, 2016.**

Admissions and applications links for each school can be found in the Idaho Schools Directory. No matter which letter you get, you still have the option to apply to any or all of Idaho's public colleges and universities under normal deadlines and be considered alongside all other in-state and out-of-state applicants.
